

Sermon Summary for Palm Sunday

Odd isn't it that we very often don't see what is really going on until we look back on an event? Even when we are personally deeply involved, we sometimes don't realise the significance of our own actions. And sometimes we don't understand the long-term consequences of how we respond to events.

But suppose we were able to see the end from the beginning and accurately predict how everyone involved would behave? We could orchestrate the immediate outcome and the lasting effects. What power that would be!

Three people can do that; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. When they act in unity, each taking their own special part, the course of history changes. It has been said "God moves in mysterious ways" but His ways are only mysterious because the full meaning of what He is doing is hidden from us and we can't see the future.

This week we will be looking at how God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit, planned and executed the greatest rescue mission ever mounted; and how the people involved didn't have any real idea what was happening or their part in shaping history.
